#### Committee Discussions

#### General Obligation Bond-Background

Staff: Dan Jung

Staff provided an update on bond planning, including recommendations for the total bond amount, duration, tax rate, and referral timeline. The staff recommendations included narrowing the bond package to \$1.5 billion – \$1.8 billion, retaining the existing tax rate, and setting an eight-year bond duration to aid in planning. Staff also recommended targeting the May 2025 ballot for referral. The committee discussed and generally supported the recommendations.

Discussions included the possibility of voters approving a higher bond amount with an increased tax rate, the risks associated with a failed bond referral, and considerations regarding the Cleveland High School modernization, including potential relocation and options for athletic facilities. The Board reviewed sample bond package options, with general support for Option 1, which prioritizes high school modernizations. Staff will refine the bond package options based on feedback and present them at a future meeting.
